|  Proposition 1 – BUILD SKILLS = JOBS.  Yes!
Investing in Texas technical colleges = better skills, better jobs. Let's build the future of our workforce. |  Proposition 9 – WORKERS WHO OWN TOOLS TO EARN INCOME WIN.  Yes!
Uplifts workers and small businesses who use their own tools, equipment, or other property to earn income to keep more of what they earn – whether you're a mechanic, landscaper, hair stylist, or small shop owner. |
|  Proposition 2 – SUPER-RICH TAX CUT.  No!
Cuts taxes for the super-rich on investments. That's not for working families—keep taxes fair. |  Proposition 10 – REBUILD AFTER FIRE.  Yes!
Fire destroys homes. Temporary tax breaks on rebuilding = real help for families in crisis. |
|  Proposition 3 – BAIL DENIALS RISK FREEDOM.  No!
Tough-on-crime sounds good, but denying bail automatically risks people's freedom without due process. |  Proposition 11 – ELDERLY & DISABLED HOME SAFETY.  Yes!
Elderly or disabled? Let them keep more of their home's value tax-free. That's dignity and fairness. |
|  Proposition 4 – WATER FOR EVERYONE.  Yes!
Dedicated sales tax revenue for water = clean, safe water for our communities. Water is life; vote like it. |  Proposition 12 – JUDGES POWER GRAB.  No!
Giving more power to sanction judges sounds tough, but it risks political abuse and unfair targeting. |
|  Proposition 5 – TAX BREAK FOR FEED SELLERS.  No!
Tax breaks for feed sellers won't help working families—they help corporations more than us. |  Proposition 13 – MORE SCHOOL TAX RELIEF  Yes!
Increasing school tax exemptions = more protection for your home and your family. |
|  Proposition 6 – WALL STREET WINS, NOT YOU.  No!
Exempting securities transactions from taxes = benefits the wealthy, not everyday Texans. |  Proposition 14 – \$3B INSTITUTE OVER SCHOOLS.  No!
\$3 billion for a dementia institute sounds nice, but is that the best use of \$3B? |
|  Proposition 7 – VETERANS' SPOUSES GET HOME SECURITY.  Yes!
Support veterans' families—let surviving spouses keep part of their home tax-free. Respect & security matter. |  Proposition 15 – POWER GRAB DISGUISED AS “PARENTS' RIGHTS”.  No!
This amendment isn't about empowering families – it's about giving politicians new ways to mess with our schools, ban books, push culture wars, and strip away protections for ALL kids. |
|  Proposition 8 – NO ESTATE TAXES = RICH WINS.  No!
Estate taxes protect wealthy families, not working Texans. |  Proposition 16 – IT'S ALREADY THE LAW, ONLY US CITIZENS VOTE.  No!
Clarifying that voters must be U.S. citizens sounds nice—but the truth is, that's already the law. This doesn't change anything. |

Tax breaks for border security property = benefits for big landowners, not working Texans. |
